Day 1: Saigon arrival - Xin chao Vietnam! Half day city tour

Arrival SAIGON, upon arrival, you will be welcomed and escorted to your hotel in Saigon downtown. Check in and relaxing

Wondering around **French quarter** with **Notre Dame Cathedral and the Old Post Office**, **Opera house**, **Ben Thanh market**.

Ho Chi Minh City, a Modern dynamic, is the largest city in Vietnam and is informally referred to as Saigon. It is remarkable for the harmonious blending of traditional values with northern and western cultural features. Skyscrapers dot the city and everywhere are the signs of growing status cars, mobile phones, upscale cafés, fine dining, and trendy nightlife. And yet the city still retains a unique Vietnamese feel with the hustle and bustle of the local markets, incessant horns, and local vendors on every street corner.

Day 2 : Mekong Delta day trip (B, L)

Today 8AM you leave Saigon and travel to the Mekong River Delta. Enjoy an early breakfast at the hotel before driving to the riverside town passing a green rice field, boarding a private boat cruise on the Mekong River, visiting a tropical fruit garden with Traditional Music, a coconut candy factory Bee farm, rowing boat,



lunch on one of the islands with great local food.

PM: Take a Motor Cart or Electricity car – Great Fun Fun. Your driver will meet you at the Pier and we drive back to Saigon for your last night in Vietnam.

Upon arrival, before exploring the tunnels, you will have some short introduction followed by introductory video about how the tunnels were constructed and how the people survived in the harsh

conditions of the war time. Then, spend your time to explore the remaining area and tunnel systems which included the special constructed living areas with kitchens, bedrooms side by side with other martial facilities like storage, weapons factories, field hospitals, and command centers helping whoever lives inside the tunnels meet their basic needs. Besides, there are also many hidden trap doors and dangerous traps within the maze-like tunnels for security purpose during the war.

Give your hands to the farmers, if you like to help, try to be a real farmer to join them plough the soil o seeding vegetables...and taking a picture to save the memorable experience. Wave your hands to the farmers; keep cycling along the farm then stop to visit a local temple



9:45-10:00 Enjoy the breath-breaking scenery of the riverside, we stop to visit one of the oldest pagodas- But Thap, and understand more about Vietnamese Buddhism dating back to the 13th century. Admire the impressionistic Buddhist statue that has a thousand arms and thousand eyes. On the way, you can see many giant old trees, meet friendly locals, take pictures of water buffaloes, etc

10:45-11:00 Cycling through the Rice Field to Dau Phu Village where you learn about how to make Dau Phu from Soybean, really interesting manual labor to make



Yummy Dau Phu for Vegetarian, is highly recommended by the local people to taste traditional Vietnamese food. Stop by the Kumquat Garden, where thousands of kumquat trees are growing and breathing fresh air in the peaceful countryside.

11:45-12:00 We keep cycling further through the Rice Field observing more local life to the dyke to visit the Ancestral Mausoleum Kinh Duong Vuong —the primitive Ancestor founder of Vietnam from BC located on the bank of the River, wandering around, and sightseeing, you can see many giant old trees, meeting friendly locals, taking pictures of water buffaloes...

12:30-13:00We have yummy lunch with a local family, you can try to cook if you want, or you are a master chef. Relax and walk around the village to visit traditional houses made from bricks and wood with tile roofs



local experience.

14:00 Next, we're cycling to Dong Ho Folk painting-UNESCO Intangible World Heritage, you love painting, and You have a chance to be an artist to draw your own pictures! Here is a unique Folk Painting which is used Gio Papers to be printed on Wood blocks with special inks from natural leaves, and shells ...the pictures are telling you about local life, festival, animals, wedding...

16:30-17:00 wandering more around to enjoy the peaceful scenery of the countryside, then we drive back to Hanoi. Or if you like to have peaceful overnight at the Village, do the homestay with the local family that would be an amazing real-life

Day 7 : Hanoi city – Ninh Binh: Trang an -Mua Cave (B):

8:00AM Today you will explore Vietnam's charming capital. With its wide tree-lined boulevards, French colonial architecture, peaceful lakes, and ancient oriental pagodas, Hanoi is an eclectic mix that offers something for everyone.

Your city tour will take you to Hanoi's key sites:

the Ho Chi Minh Complex (Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum and stilt house), the nearby One Pillar Pagoda; the Presidential Palace

Then continue our journey to Ninh Binh province. Have lunch in a local restaurant (arranged by clients).

Visit Trang A Grotto - that was recognized by UNESCO as A World Heritage Site in 2014. Trang An has a wonderful tunnel cave system and hundreds of limestones.

Explore Mua Cave (Dancing Cave) to walk up almost 500 steps, you can reach the top of Lying Dragon Mountain & have an amazing panoramic view of Tam Coc from here. This could be the best photo spot for Ninh Binh.

Day 8 Ninh Binh – Halong Bay – Lan Ha Bay Cruise (B, L, D):

8:00-8:30 AM After breakfast, we drive 2,5 hours to Halong bay the UNESCO World Heritage Site.

The scenery of Halong Bay where thousands of limestone islands jut out of the



emerald sea, sculpted into bizarre shapes is truly an iconic image for Vietnam. An **overnight relaxing boat** trip is the best way to enjoy this must-see natural wonder of Vietnam.

On arrive at the jetty in Halong City around noon, proceeding with check-in formalities. After a welcome onboard,

lunch will be served while cruising towards the bay itself.

In the afternoon, the program also includes more activities such as swimming or



kayaking (excluded from the cruise package) or cave visits on the vast sea, cooking class onboard to challenge your skills in preparing a very famous Vietnamese dish (depending on each boat's itinerary) or you can just spend some time relaxing on board.

Towards the end of the day the boat sets anchor for the night among the karst formations. Dinner is served on board.

dock and drive to Noi Bai International Airport.

reflecting the richness of Lao culture dating from the days of the early kings right through the last sovereign. Wat Xiengthong. We also have enough time this day to explore some other landmarks, including the impressive stupa of Wat Visoun, the shrine of Wat Aham,

the city's oldest temple of Wat Sene and the Wat Mai with five tiered roofs. A visit to Luang Prabang would be not complete without climbing 329 steps to the top of Phousi Hill for a beautiful sunset view of the Mekong River. The zigzag path crosses over various temples to the sacred, gilded stupa of Wat Phou, another World Heritage Site,

recognized by UNESCO in 2002si at the summit. Overnight in Luang Prabang.

Day 11 Luang Prabang Luang Prabang - Alm Giving observation - Pak Ou cave – Koungsi waterfall (B):



Rise up bit early to observe Alm Giving, the most authentic local culture of Laos, the monks will go around to collect the Alms then give to others!

Then back to your hotel to have breakfast, we then board a cruise upstream on the Mekong River, which also gives us a beautiful view of the tranquil countryside

as well as an interesting visit to the mysterious of Pak Ou Caves, crammed with thousands of gold lacquered Buddha statues of various shapes and sizes.

Afternoon, we take a drive (30 km South) to visit Kuangsi Waterfall, which, though not very high, is spectacular and really beautiful with its green surroundings as the preserved National park. We stop en-route, stop to visit a fresh produced market namely Talad

Phosy, and also visit Ban Na Oune, a small village of a hill-tribe group "Hmong", probably the best-known minority group in Laos. Late afternoon return to town Overnight in Luangprabang Meal included: Breakfast
